



Significant Usability Improvements Coming to the Ounet System on March 17, 2026

In 2024, we introduced a new web technology to the Ounet user interface. Since then, our focus has been on enhancing the usability and functionality of the interface.

The usability improvements will be released in several phases. The first release on March 17 will introduce redesigned user interfaces for devices, alarms, and event logs. The new views follow an updated theme, ensuring a more consistent, easier-to-use, and easier-to-learn user interface. Table views have been renewed and standardized across all views. Terminology used throughout the system has also been unified and clarified.



We will continue developing Ounet and will update the remaining views to match the new theme in upcoming releases.

- > Added a left-hand navigation tree dedicated to asset management
- > Updated the appearance of the navigation tree

- > Added a user breadcrumb path to all redesigned views: "account > site > function"

- > Redesigned the events table view
- > Clarified search functionalities


Alarms

- > Active Alarms
 - Redesigned the table view for active alarms
 - Updated acknowledgement buttons and alarm status indicators
- > Alarm History
 - Redesigned the table view for alarm history
 - Updated the design of the time selector and quick selections
- > Alarm Routing
 - Redesigned the alarm routing calendar
 - Updated the editing view for alarm routing
- > Alarm Groups
 - Redesigned the table view for alarms
 - Updated the editing view for alarm groups
 - Added a new dedicated navigation tree for alarm groups

Devices

- > Added a separate navigation tree for devices and device point groups
- > Added a separate tab for device points
- > Devices
 - Redesigned the table view for devices
 - Updated the device add/edit view
- > Device Points
 - Redesigned the device point table

Across all new views, we have focused on ensuring that similar functions appear visually consistent, making them easier for users to understand and use.
